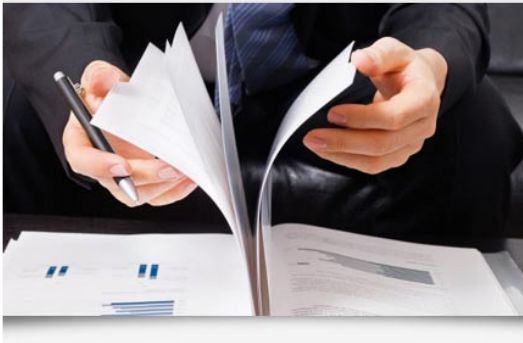


DIVE "Drop-In Visit evaluation"

Let our professionals drop-in to assess your ATF vulnerability.



An *FFLGuard* "Drop In Visit evaluation" (DIVE) is considered neither a Basic Service, which are services included as part of your Yearly Fee to *FFLGuard*, nor an Additional Service, which are add-on services you can pay for to enhance your internal compliance levels. It is an Optional Service, in that either we can do it unannounced and at our own discretion (with no cost to you), or you can request and schedule it (at an additional charge to you). It is, simply put, a "house call" to your business where our professionals observe whether you have implemented our Law Plus Guidelines and evaluate your potential vulnerabilities if an ATF inspection were to occur imminently. We classify these DIVEs

into two groups: the **StandardDIVE** or a **DeepDIVE**.

A **StandardDIVE** is 90-120 minutes on site by one of our Professionals, who measures a variety of different compliance elements within the store in a spot check fashion, including:

- Form 4473 compliance
- A&D record compliance
- Partial inventory
- Law Plus Guidelines tally
- Internal (*employee, customers*) threat assessment
- External (*ATF, criminal, plaintiff law suit*) threat assessment

Cost: **StandardDIVE** costs \$600 plus travel.
(we divide travel costs among clients by visiting multiple DIVE sites in one day)

The **DeepDIVE** is longer, farther reaching, and more comprehensive. It includes all parts of the **StandardDIVE**, except with an on-site visit from our Professional for no less than one (1) full day, off site monitoring for an additional five (5) days after that, a more extensive inventory review, and a conference call/video conference with counsel to supplement an Attorney/Client privileged report that details our findings and suggests courses of action.

Cost: \$1250 per day, with a one (1) day minimum plus travel.
(mandatory "first step" for any client who joins us "HOT")

All DIVEs, done at either our discretion or at your request, afford the client an additional 2 points toward their Law Plus Guideline requirements.
